Family Camp 2010 Children's Ministry Program Information

Greetings in the Name of our Lord!

It is time to plan for Family Camp 2010. We look forward to a **great** week of ministry and fun. Please take a few minutes to read this information on Children's Ministry opportunities available during the week.

Nursery:

Changes worked out great last summer and will continue this summer. We have divided this age into 4 smaller groups instead of one big one.

- Infants (birth-6 months)
- Wobblers (6-12 months)
- Tykes (12-24 months)
- Toddlers (2 & 3 yr olds not yet potty trained)

The Infants, Wobblers, & Tykes will meet in the three rooms of the Nursery. Toddlers will meet on the south end of the Fellowship Hall, just across from the Nursery. Each room will be clearly labeled. **Every child will need to be signed in by a parent or guardian.** The nursery age children will start in their classroom every morning & evening. Nursery children will be enjoying age-appropriate faith based curriculum.

3 yrs old-1st grade:

These children will be divided into 4 age-group classes which offer songs, games, crafts, videos & Bible stories. Snacks and organized recreation are also provided. This ministry is available during Bible studies and Worship services.

2nd-5th Grade/God Squad:

Children's Evangelists Paul & Jessica Dietzel from Servant Hands Ministry will be returning for another fun-filled year. This ministry will take place during Bible studies and Worship services starting on Saturday. Crafts, snacks and organized recreation are available Monday-Friday mornings.

Parents of 6th graders:

Those children going into 6th grade may register for the God Squad Program or the Jr. High program. Please help them chose **one** (no switching back and forth).

Junior and Senior High:

These ministries take place under the leadership of Youth Dean Jesse Karls. Programming is available during Bible studies with additional evening activities offered throughout the week.

You will be asked to volunteer your time in your children's classes. Parents need to serve in at least one session per child (maximum of four times). Your help is an absolute must if we are to continue Children's Programming. Due to the size of each class, our staff simply cannot run the programs without your help. Ministries will be much more fun and effective for everyone with the presence of extra helping hands.

Parents of Teens: Please consider still donation your time to this ministry. What a joy to experience the Children's Ministry first hand! C.D's of the service of Bible study you miss are available free of charge if you indicate your "volunteer efforts" on the order form.

Please Note: If your children have serious food allergies we are asking you to provide snacks for them in the mornings. Also, please notify the teachers of any allergies. We feel this is in the best interest of your child and important for their safety.

Please be prompt in picking your children up after activities. Parents/Grandparents, not older siblings, are asked to pick up young children 1st grade & below.

Please educate your child to basic camp rules.

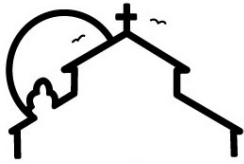
- Shoes must be worn on grounds at all times.
