



Dining Hall Update

Well, it's official, after the Dining Hall expansion/renovation project hit a road block last fall with the new enforcement of "Flood Zone restrictions," the plans for the project have been scaled back to stay below the threshold of needing to raise the entire structure above the 100 year flood mark. With that done, the Board of Directors gave preliminary approval to the project at its May

meeting. We are currently finalizing the "working set of prints" so that we can send the project out for bids. A preliminary cost projection brought the project in at around \$140,000 before furnishings. We currently have a little over \$150,000 on hand, so we are hopeful that we have enough to fund the entire project. This will remove the existing support posts in the center section, place a new concrete floor with radiant floor heating, bathrooms in the "lounge" area, a full insulation package, and possibly even air conditioning. We will change the seating from long benches to round tables to be more conducive to conversation. The timeline is to begin work as soon as our fall schedule permits, probably mid- to late-October, with a projected finish date of February of 2010. We are planning on having the benches in the auction this fall for those who want to take home a remembrance of the "old days." The Master Plan has begun to shift its sights toward the next project which is the construction of a swimming pool at camp. Funds are now being raised, so if you have a heart's desire to help make this project a reality, please send your designated gift to the camp. Our dream would be to have the pool in place for our 100th year celebration in 2011.
