July 24-31, 2010

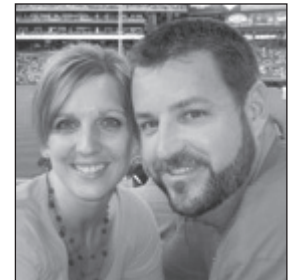

As we get ready to celebrate 100 years of Ministry and look forward to the future of the Camp, we still see the Ladies as a key part in what happens on these grounds. **If you are interested in helping with the health kits, here are the items they are looking for:**

*1 hand towel, 1 wash cloth, 1 comb, 1 nail file or fingernail clippers, 1 bath size bar of soap, 1 toothbrush, 6 plastic strip sterile bandages, and \$1.00 for the purchase of toothpaste (place items, including \$1.00 in a large ziplock bag)*

All items included in the kits must be NEW items. All emergency kits are carefully planned to make them usable in the greatest number of situations. Since strict rules often govern product entry into international countries, it is important that kits contain only the requested items — nothing more. Please do NOT include any personal notes or additional materials in the kits.

You can bring your items to Family Camp or drop off at the camp office during office hours. Thank you in advance for your help in this mission project. God bless.
