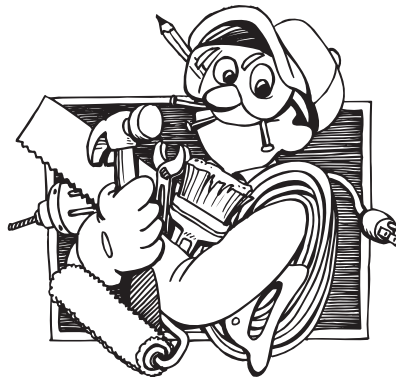


Kick-Off Celebration – April 17 @ 5 p.m.
